Use shading by pressing hard and soft to create the fading from dark green to light green



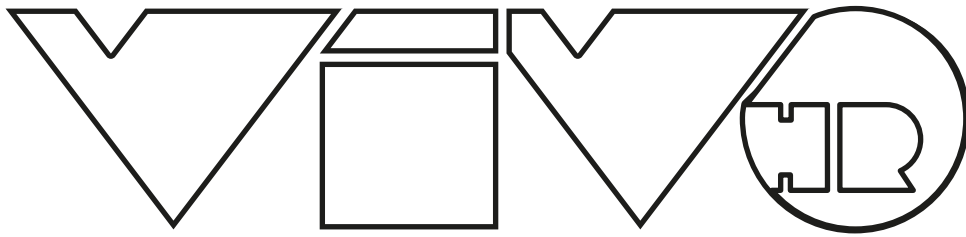

Colour the background objects first, in this case the gold 'GP'





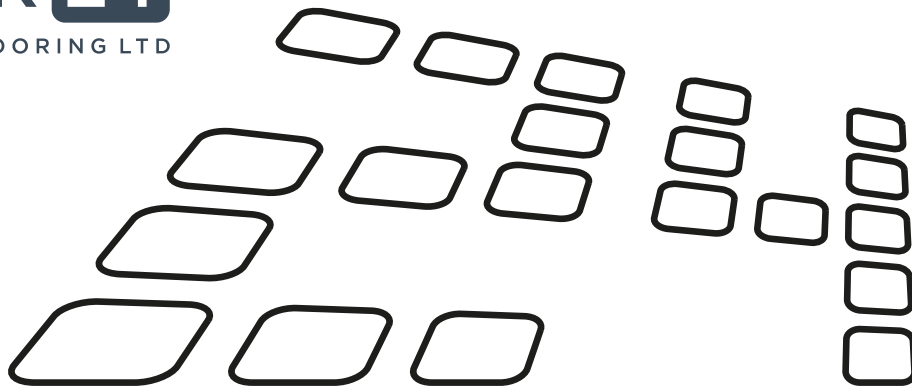

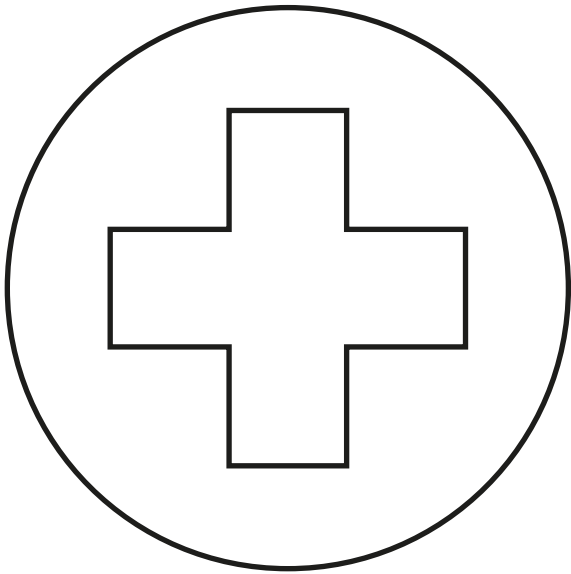
